Dear Prospective Counselor-in-Training (CIT),

Thank you for your interest in becoming a CIT for the 2026 summer season! As a CIT, you will learn leadership skills including program planning, teamwork, and mentoring younger campers. CITs have increased privileges and responsibilities at YMCA Camp Kresge and have a unique opportunity to make friends from around the world. All teens who are 15 or 16 years old are eligible to apply as a CIT, whether or not they have been to YMCA Camp Kresge before.

Due to the nature of our CIT program, we ask all campers to submit an application along with their registration form and deposit. Directors at camp will read through your application and will be in touch through email or phone regarding your acceptance into our program, or if we have any questions for you. Depending on the number of applications we receive, we may contact you for an additional phone interview or ask for references. Parents: deposits will not be processed until we are in touch about the status of your camper's application.

Financial assistance is available for all YMCA Camp Kresge programs. The YMCA Camp Kresge Scholarship Application is available at the front desk of the Wilkes Barre YMCA, online at [wvymca.org/branch/camp-kresge](http://wvymca.org/branch/camp-kresge) or by calling the Camp Office. Assistance is available on a first come, first served basis, so please get your information in early!

We hope that this transparency will be seen as an added level of security in our communication, while allowing CITs to take on the responsibility of responding.

Being a CIT is different from being a camper. As a CIT, we will ask you to be a role model for other campers. While camp is always a place to have fun and make friends, you will have sessions that feel more like school. We may ask you to take notes on what you have learned and observe other staff and programs. How can you find a balance between having fun and taking your position as a CIT seriously?

There will be parts of camp that feel like work. This might include assisting staff with cleaning camp, responsibilities of helping care for younger campers, and making sure your leadership trip runs smoothly. Please write down experiences you have working or volunteering with someone who gave you responsibilities to be completed. How did it feel? What did you learn?

As a role model, we expect our CITs to stay alcohol, drug, and tobacco free. We ask all campers to leave their cell phones at home, or turn them into the camp office when they arrive at camp. Can you commit to these expectations?
